

Rain Barrels At Your Home

Do you know that you can actually harvest rainwater and save them for future use? Yes, with the use of rain barrels, you can actually use the water for your garden. If you are using residential irrigation, this will save you around 40 percent of your total water consumption. Of course it is not only for watering your plants. For cleaning the house or for washing your car, you can also use the water. Also, should there be a shortage or in need of water for any emergency, you can use the water that you have saved.

If you are looking for ways to make your home more energy efficient, using rain water is one of the easiest ways to do so. The reason is that rain water is the easiest ways to harvest with any of the rain barrels in many stores around, not to mention that it is the most abundant natural resource. All you have to do is to get yourself this simple device, place it strategically under your gutter and it will do the rest. It will collect the water for your future use. Consider how much you can actually save for the entire year.

This is not really something new, this energy innovation. Man has actually been saving water in containers and use them around the house since the dawn of civilization. Today with slight improvement in this practice, homeowners can actually use the same water saving technique in their own homes. What are actually needed are cisterns that will store rain water that falls in the roof of the house. These will collect the water, instead of the storm drain or in the lawns of the house. Usually the cisterns are concrete and are large enough to store large amount of water. However today, plastic drums or barrels can now be used in place of the concrete cisterns. You can use several barrels or plastic containers as cistern by connecting them together with a pipe using a spigot attached on the lower part of the barrel. The last barrel should then have an overflow drain which can direct the extra water on a drain.

After you have decided to have your own rain barrel, what you must remember is that you should always use a tight fitting lid for safety. This will make sure that children and even animals will be safe from accidentally drowning from your collected water. This will also make sure that algae will not form in your water. You should also have screen cover to keep out the debris. And always check it for any overflow and blockage in between the rain barrels.
