Other things to be mindful of are the speed and dependability of the colocation hosting server, an unreliable one may not be there when you need it. Also be sure to weigh where the server of the colocation hosting you are using is. If your server and your colocation hosting server are too close together then they may be impacted by the same disturbance. Significant space separating the servers will increase the probability that one of the servers will be functioning which means that you are not losing valuable business time and potential.
